The awards recognise dedicated volunteers and sporting achievement during 2011.

Who can be nominated?

- Anyone who lives within the Havant Borough local authority boundary
- Anyone who attends a sports club in the Havant Borough area
- Anyone who attends a school or college in the Havant Borough area

What do you need to tell us in your supporting statement?

For each nomination you are asked to provide a supporting statement to help make the case for your candidate. This allows us to assess the relative merits of each nomination. You should explain why your nomination deserves to win, outline their achievements and clearly explain how the nominee meets the criteria for the award category, which are listed below:

Met or exceeded their performance goals during 2011. Acts as a positive role model and inspiration to others within Havant Borough.
Youth Team (U18) Senior Team of the Year	Achieved success and performed at a consistently high level throughout 2011. Demonstrated fair play and a good sporting attitude over the last 12 months.
Coach Award	Inspired and encouraged athletes/ players to take up and progress in their sport. Shows a positive attitude, is able to inspire others and has excellent dedication. Provides high quality coaching and shows innovation.

<p>Young Volunteer Award</p>	<p>Demonstrates enthusiasm and commitment to their sport/club.</p> <p>Made a significant impact on their club//sport through volunteering.</p> <p>Demonstrates a positive and ‘professional’ attitude.</p>
<p>Service to Sport</p>	<p>Contributed significantly to their sport/club over a long period of time.</p> <p>Demonstrated long standing commitment and dedication to their sport/club.</p> <p>Continually inspired and encouraged others during their involvement in their sport/club.</p>
<p>Special Merit Award</p>	<p>Candidate deserves recognition for a special achievement during 2011</p>
<p>Club of the Year</p>	<p>This award is for a club that has achieved some, or all, of the following: Gained or attained an National Governing Body (NGB) accreditation; demonstrated successful partnerships with local schools and community groups; is committed to volunteer recruitment, recognition and training; has increased it’s membership and participation levels.</p>
<p>Official of the Year</p>	<p>Demonstrates commitment as an official, umpire or referee together with commitment to their own personal development.</p>
