Your pull-out guide to collections until December 2018

The guide provides bin collection dates for 2018, a list of items you can recycle and a Christmas timetable, helping to make your weekly collections easier to plan.

What goes where?

Sorting out your waste for collection helps improve recycling rates. Please ensure your recycling is clean and dry and that the following items end up in the correct bin:

Recycling

- Greetings cards and envelopes
- Cardboard
- Food and drinks cans
- Aerosol cans
- Plastic bottles
- Newspapers and magazines

General waste

- Gift-wrap
- General household rubbish
- Black sacks and carrier bags
- Drinks cartons
- Plastic/polystyrene packaging
- Food trays
- Margarine tubs
- Yoghurt pots

Bottle bank

- Glass bottles and jars
- Empty wine and sherry bottles
- Beer bottles
- Pickle jars

Please note over Christmas:

There are a few extra things to be aware of over Christmas regarding waste and recycling collections. A revised timetable will be running over the Christmas period (see the back page of this four-page guide), but also:

Additional bag collections

- Over the Christmas period, one additional bag of waste will be collected
- Additional recycling is collected all year. Please ensure it is placed in a clear sack or untied carrier bag

Garden waste

- The garden waste collection service is suspended between Monday 25 December 2017 and Friday 5 January 2018. If you are a member your Christmas tree can be collected as garden waste, as long as the tree is cut into pieces no bigger than 75mm (three inches) in diameter

Full bottle banks

- If a bottle bank is full due to seasonal demand, please do not leave glass by the bank. Visit www.recyclenow.com/bank-locator for a list of alternative sites
