

Conditions for Resident's Scratch cards

- The scratch card is only valid if the driver has scratched off all sections showing the day & date that the vehicle is parked. Only one box in each section should be scratched
- 2. The scratch card must be clearly displayed so that all sections are visible to the Civil Enforcement Officer
- 3. A scratch card is only valid for the date that has been scratched off. If you stay longer you must display a further scratch card at the expiry of the first ticket. Only one scratch card can be displayed at any one time
- 4. Proof of residency must be provided for scratch cards to be issued. i.e. utility bill or council tax bill
- 5. The scratch cards should only be issued to bona fide visitors to the address shown on the application form for which they are issued
- 6. A scratch card is only valid for one use
- 7. Any alterations to the information shown on the scratch card shall make it invalid
- 8. Parking is only permitted in the permit holder only bays within the zone stated on the scratch card
- 9. The issue of a scratch card does not guarantee the availability of a parking space
- 10. A maximum of 10 books can be purchased within a 12 month period at a cost of £5 per book.
- 11. No refund is given on part used books
- 12. Any breach of these conditions or failure to display a valid scratch card may result in a Penalty Charge Notice being issued
