THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF THE BOROUGH OF HAVANT BYELAWS FOR GOOD RULE AND GOVERNMENT

Byelaws made under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the Council of the Borough of Havant for the good rule and government of the Borough of Havant and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

Extent

1. These byelaws apply to the specified parts of the Borough of Havant designated in the Schedule to the byelaws and hereinafter referred to as the "designated areas".

Skateboarding

2. No person shall skate, slide or ride on rollers, skateboards, wheels, mechanical contrivances or other equipment in a designated area.

Penalty

3. Any person offending against byelaw 2 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

Schedule

The designated areas referred to in byelaw 2 and delineated by black hatching on the plans attached to these byelaws are as follows:

- (a) The pedestrian area at London Road, Waterlooville including London Road Precinct, Queens Parade, Wellington Way Precinct, the subway, ramps and steps adjacent to 127a London Road, Dukes Walk and the Precinct between London Road and Dukes Walk
- (b) The Greywell and Park Parade Precincts at Leigh Park, Havant
