


# Havant Panel Clean Up survey



## **Where else do you think we could undertake a neighbourhood clean-up?**

From the comments received they can be broken down into various themes: -

- Litter along roads and alleyways
- Bins to be emptied more often
- Brambles and overhanging trees need to be cut back
- Dog owners who do not clear up after their dogs, need to be fined
- Fly tipping needs clearing
- Grass needs cutting
- Emsworth underpass needs clearing
- Gutters and drains need clearing
- Road signs need cleaning, visible (overhanging trees etc cut back) and 'temporary' signs removed
- Litter around shops / fast food outlets
- Litter around town centres
- Weeds need removing
- Private gardens – need to keep overhanging plants cut back
