(b) Installations for the disposal of waste (unless included in Schedule 1)

Either—

Is the development likely to have significant effects on the environment?

The proposal does not involve the disposal of waste by incineration nor will it result in any adverse effect on controlled waters. The site area does not exceed 0.5ha.

Due to there being no further changes to the development than what is already permitted, and the nature of the proposal being an extension of time with no further intensification being proposed, it is considered that the development is



unlikely to have any significant effects on the environment and therefore does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment.

The proposed development is not an EIA development under the *Town & Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017* as there is no further changes to the development and the nature of the proposal is not likely to result in any significant environmental effects.
