Havant Borough Local Development Framework

Notice of adoption of Havant Borough Core Strategy 1 March 2011

In accordance with Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and Regulation 24(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, notice is hereby given that Havant Borough Council adopted its Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD) on Tuesday 1 March 2011.

The Core Strategy is the principal document in the council's Local Development Framework (LDF). It covers the Borough of Havant and sets out the spatial planning strategy for the area up to 2026.

Mr G Salter BA MRTPI, an Independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government considered the Core Strategy at an Examination in Public held between 2 June 2010 and 29 December 2010. The hearing sessions were held between 7 and 16 September. The final Inspector's Report and its recommendations was received by the council on 29 December 2010. The Inspector found the Core Strategy sound subject to a limited number of changes. These changes were incorporated into the adopted Core Strategy.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made no later than the end of the six week period from the date of the adoption. This date is 12 April 2011.

The Core Strategy, the Sustainability Appraisal, the Inspector's Report and all material relating to the examination process will be available to view as soon as reasonably practicable on the council's website at www.havant.gov.uk

Copies of the adopted Core Strategy, Sustainability Appraisal, the Proposals Map, this Adoption Statement and the Inspector's Report will be available for inspection as soon as reasonably practicable at the Civic Offices, Havant, Hampshire PO9 2AX from Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm.
