43% of respondents have lived in their local area for over 20 years.

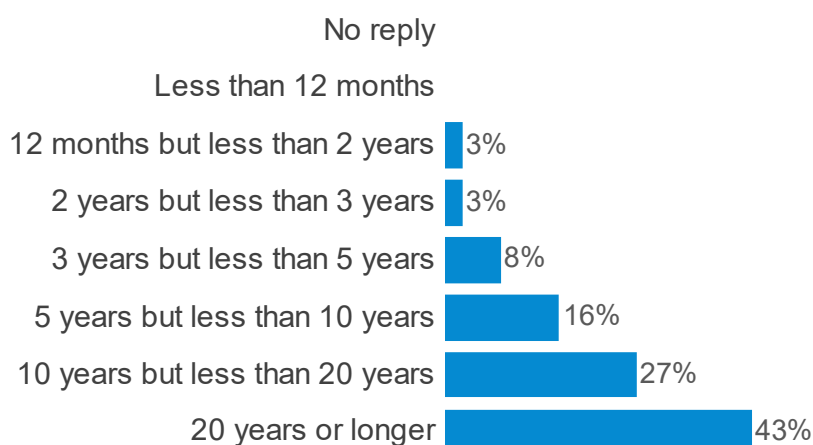
Most respondents (78%) feel they belong in their immediate neighbourhood.

60% are fairly satisfied with their local area as a place to live.

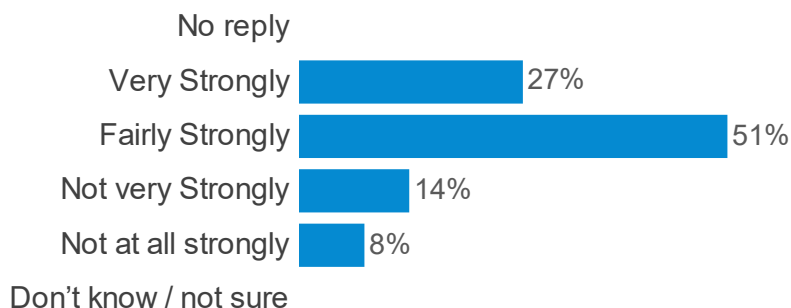
Anti-social behaviour (78%), litter and dirt in streets (49%), traffic congestion (46%), public transport (43%) and access to recreational facilities (27%) were the five things chosen as those that would have the most impact on making somewhere a good place to live.

Traffic congestion (43%), activities for young people (30%), weeds and moss on pavement (27%), public transport (27%) and level of anti-social behaviour (24%) are the top five things that respondents feel need improving.

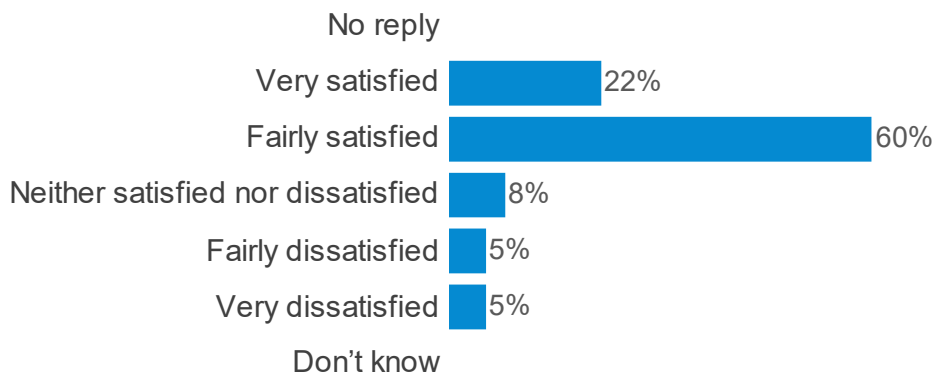
How long have you lived in your local area?



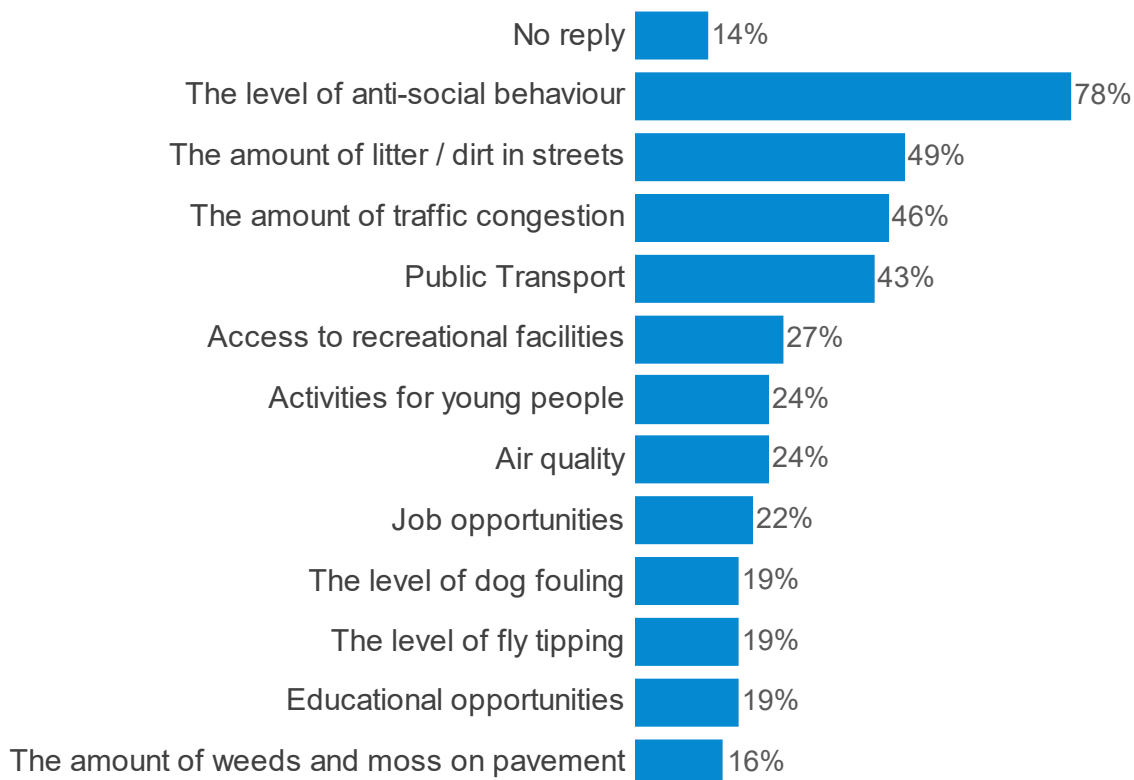
How strongly do you feel you belong to your immediate neighbourhood?
